Are you exposed?

Then there's the pending **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)**, and the impact it will have on your business: if you're found not to be compliant with the new regulations, the consequences are not only reputational (just think TalkTalk ...). Brexit notwithstanding, you will need to conform with EU regulations - and it is suggested that the "policy bar" will actually be set higher for the UK. Fines will be set at 2% of worldwide turnover or EUR 1m.
